“PIAN Massage Therapy Training”

Parola Inter-agency Network (PIAN) livelihood cluster starts the year with Pilot massage therapy training held at Manila Manpower Development (MMDC) center in Tayuman, Manila. The training started on January 10, 2023 and will end on February 3, 2023. This is funded by International Container Terminal Services (ICTSI). This is a 20-days comprehensive training that includes lecture and actual demonstration of massage therapy. It also includes modules on Thai and Shiatsu massage. After the training, they will undergo assessment for a National Certificate and 80 hours on job training.

The participants in the training are 3 ALSA Buhay learners 1 elementary, 2 JHS and 2 (4ps) parents and 1 from Barangay of Tondo. Six (6) participants each will receive a starter kit for them to start their massage service.



PAYATAS THANKSGIVING MASS


January 13, 2023



Their diligence, sacrifices, determination and sleepless nights during the review paid off. Again, Congratulations Newly Licensed Professional Teachers!


