

Under Department of Education (DepEd) Order No. 27, series 2018 (Amendment to DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2015, or the High School Graduates Who are Eligible to Enroll in Higher Education Institutions in School Year 2016-2017, in Relation to ALS). Prior to the pandemic, passing the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Test was one of the prerequisites of the Alternative Learning System (ALS) to qualify Learners to proceed to High school, College or Universities and for Skills Development Training. However, during the pandemic School Year 2020, the DEPED implemented Portfolio Assessment as an alternative measure. Portfolio is a compilation of learners' works, reflection and progress all throughout the process.

The Initial Assessment is conducted on March 1-31, 2023 facilitated by the Learning Facilitators of both Payatas and Parola Centers respectively. The learner's best works are evaluated and strengths and weaknesses are identified. Constructive feedback was pointed out to each learner for

improvement to ensure that the presentation of the portfolio is accurate. The second level of assessment is the District Validation from April 11-28. The final Assessment is on May 1-31, 2023.

**Theme: "Journey Thru Service"**









On March 16 and 17, 2023, Parola Center conducted the Learners formation on **"The Disaster Preparedness and Open House Activities"**. Under the supervisions of the Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP) National Capital Region (NCR), Tondo Substation Personnel, Senior Fire Officer 4 (SFO4) Francisco R. Montervirgen, Fire Officer 1 (FO1) Kenneth T. Soriano, and Senior Superintendent (S/SUPT) Christine D. Cula, District Fire Marshal. They discussed how to be prepared for disaster. They demonstrate the use of the fire extinguisher and execute Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR). They also tackled the different Fire Equipments and Their Uses. The activity ended with the demonstration of learners handling fire extinguishers.

The formation was very informative while new practical things have learned that can be applied in times of disaster.



**Theme: "Fire Drill and Safety Seminar"**

March 16, 2023



On March 17, 2023, the Payatas Center conducted a Learners formation on "Fire Drill and Safety Seminar", under the supervisions of Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP), Payatas, Quezon City, Senior Fire Officer 2 (SFO2) Manuel P. Gimeno, Fire Officer 1 (FO1) Ishmael N. Hassan, and FO1 Maria Jessica Negrete. Scholars and ALSA Buhay Learners from Elementary and Junior High Schools attended.

The speakers discussed the Fundamental Fire Safety knowledge; they focused on the residential structures and included the instructions on how to use fire extinguisher properly and tackled the proper behavior during the earthquake, applying the Duck, Cover and Hold position. The different kind of Fire Equipment and their uses demonstrate were discussed and showed the use of the Fire Fighting Equipment.

All participants did the actual exercise on Earthquake Drill after given a thorough explanation and instructions. This activity is significant to raise awareness, dispel panic, and ensure the safety and security.


