The District Validation is conducted. This is to evaluate the learners' portfolios to determine their preparedness to take an Inter-District Revalidation and to ensure that all the requirements have been completed. Each learning strand contains a minimum of 28 or a maximum of 35 work samples or projects with self-reflection, including the modules, and other important documents needed for the assessment.

The 1ST District Portfolio Validation was done on April 28, 2023 at Cecilio Apostol Elementary School facilitated by the ALS Coordinator Ms. Anna Del Rosario and Parola Learning Facilitators. Twenty-eight (28) learners from Puso Sa Puso-Parola Center passed. Three (3) from the Elementary and Twenty-five (25) from Junior High School.

On May 10, 2023, 2nd Batch of District Portfolio Validation was continued at Cecilio Apostol Elementary School. Forty-nine (49) Puso Sa Puso- Parola Center learners successfully completed the Second District Portfolio Validation. Thirty-two (32) from Junior High School and seventeen (17) from the Elementary level. This assessment was conducted by our District ALS Coordinator Ms. Anna Del Rosario and assisted by Puso Sa Puso Parola Staff's.

The total number of passers of the District Portfolio Revalidation in Parola Center is Seventy-seven (77) learners. Twenty (20) from Elementary Level and Fifty-seven (57) from Junior High School (JHS). All the passers will still undergo the Inter-District Revalidation on July 1 – 30, 2023.

The qualified learners will undergo a District Validation and Inter-District Revalidation - the Presentation of Portfolio at the Payatas Center on May 15 & 19, 2023, which will serve as their final assessment. The validators are Ms. Marilyn S. Vergara and Mr. Roderick Pagala, Master Teacher, both from the Quezon City Division Office assisted by the Learning Facilitators.

The said revalidation consists 3 categories; work samples, interview, oral reading and writing proficiency. This process measures the readiness and ability to answer questions about the projects done, personal lessons and learnings



“PAROLA INTER-AGENCY NETWORK 2ND QUARTER MEETING”


May 30, 2023
