


Leaders organized surprise celebrations for their teachers, preparing short videos, food, and gifts. Selected students shared heartfelt messages of gratitude.



### **“Road Safety for Children Program – Parola Center”**

October 11, 2024

On October 11, 2024, in partnership with the International Container Terminal Services, Inc. (ICTSI) and the Parola Inter-agency Network (PIAN), a road safety program for children was launched at the Rosauro Almario Elementary School (1012 Kagitingan St., Tondo, Manila). Various PIAN partners attended. Approximately 600 students from the school participated.

Puso Sa Puso staff — Mr. Darren M. Ilarina (Learning Facilitator/Assistant Supervisor-Parola), Learning Facilitators Mr. Errol Rodel, LPT and Ms. Elijah Echevaria, Ms. Lucita Casero (Livelihood Coordinator)—served as the facilitators. The program covered four modules: Module 1 (Situation in Parola), Module 2 (Traffic Signs and Symbols), Module 3 (General Road Safety), and Module 4 (Safety Measures). In addition to providing crucial information, participants demonstrated safety measures.





### **“Seminar on Mental Health and Drug Prevention Awareness”**


October 18, 2024






### **“Enfants Du Mekong: 30 Years in the Philippines”**


October 20, 2024


