




### **Payatas Center: Jhun Marquez**


**“Puso sa Puso Edukasyon, Inc - Parola & Payatas Center Now Accepting

### **“Livelihood program: Massage therapy skills training”**

On June 4, the orientation for 16 participants of the massage therapy training commenced at Puso Sa Puso Edukasyon Learning Center in Parola, Binondo, Manila. The instructor, Ms. Isabel Laforteza from Manila Manpower Development Center in Tayuman, Manila, is leading the training.


The participants are Alsa Buhay alumni and partners from PIAN (Parola Inter-Agency Network). The training is scheduled to last for 20 days. All participants are provided with the necessary materials for the massage, including their uniform scrub suits. They are learning about the five vital signs: blood pressure, pulse rate, respiratory rate, body temperature, and pain scale. Additionally, they are being taught Thai massage, Swedish massage, foot reflexology, and hand reflexology.

Upon completion of the training, the participants will undergo an assessment. If they pass, they will receive the National Certificate (NC2). Graduation will be granted to those who successfully finish their training under MMDC (Manila Manpower Development Center).



### **“Staff Development & Team Building 2024”**


June 26- 28, 2024
