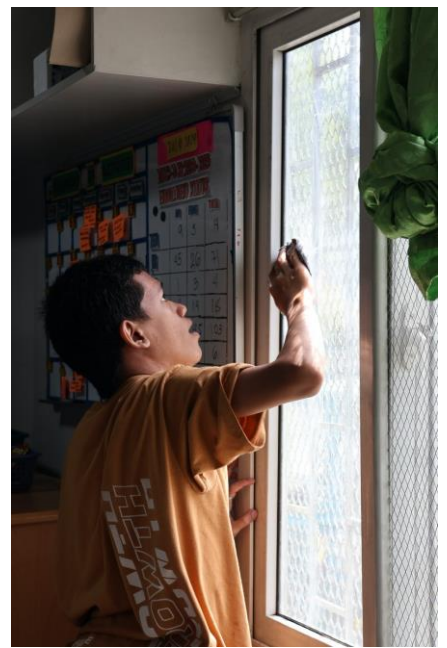

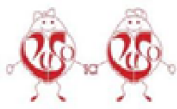

July 29, 2024

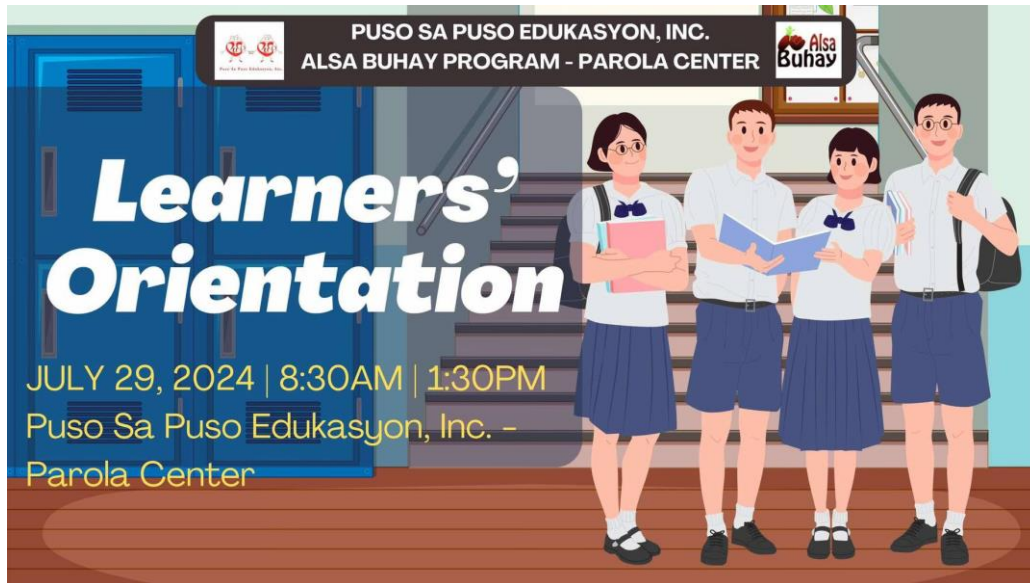
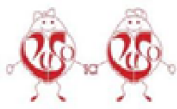
