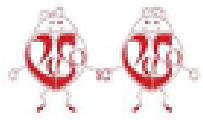

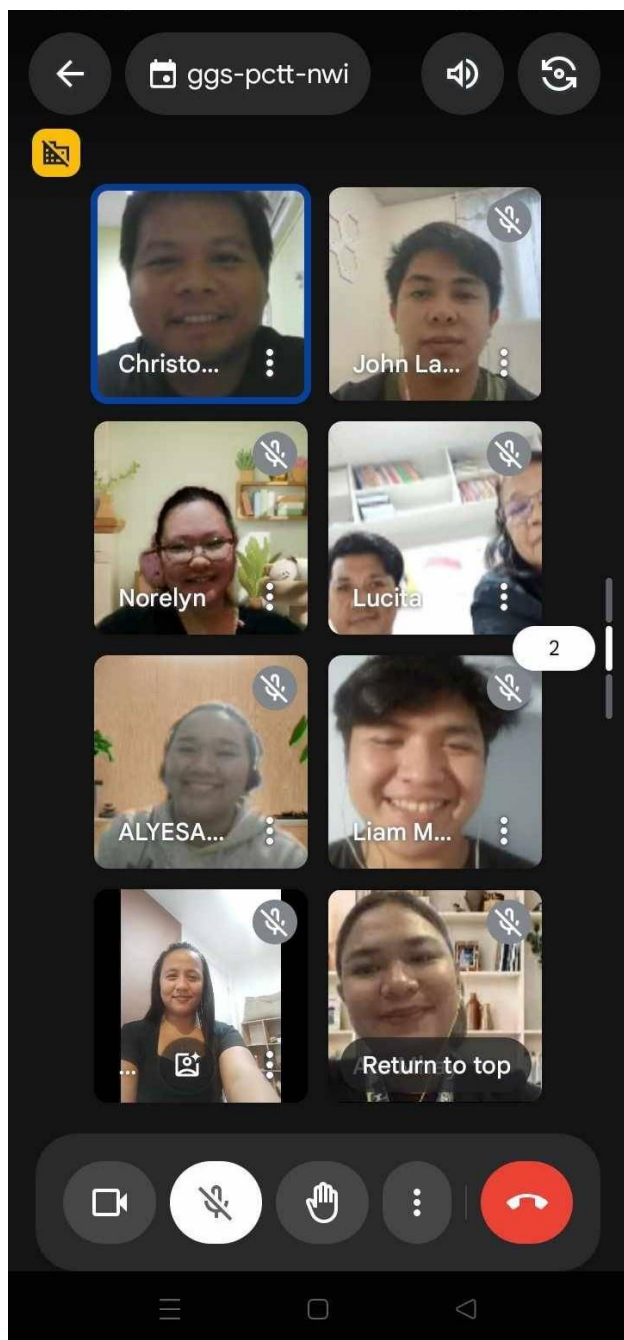
“Puso Embarks on Exciting Partnership with Philippine Christian University-Social Work Department”

September 4-5, 2024

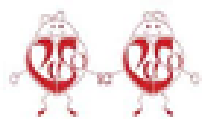

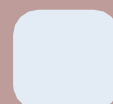
“Eskwelahan Ng Buhay Parents Orientation- Parola Center”

The orientation began led by Ms. Jen Basconillo, RSW. This session served as a crucial platform to engage parents and guardians, ensuring their active participation in the program's success.

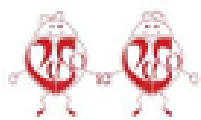

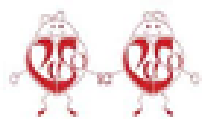
“Puso Sa Puso Welcomes New (EDM) Enfants Du Mekong Coordinator”

“A Heartfelt Tribute to 14 Years of Service: Dr. Anthony Poli and the 5-Day Dental Activity”

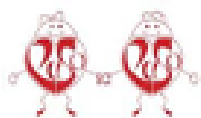
March 17, 2024

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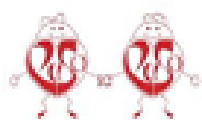
