Indeed! Fr. Jordan is a blessing to everyone! May his mission and miracle deeds intercede to everyone!



ALS Portfolio Assessment Revalidation: Payatas and Parola Center

May 6 and 13, 2021, May 10 and 17, 2021



The Bureau of Education Assessment announced the cancellation of 2019 Computer-Based A&E Test due to the restrictions imposed by the government in view of the COVID-19 pandemic. In connection to the aforesaid test, the Department of Education, through the Curriculum and Instruction strand, and the ALS Task Force announced that this year will conduct a Portfolio Assessment for Elementary and Junior High School completers of 2019.

The result of the learners' portfolio assessment presentation was used as the basis of their Passed and Failed marks in ALS. Learners who met the minimum required points were eligible to receive Elementary and Junior High School diploma and certificate of Completion. To ensure and justify the learners' original output of their portfolio, a revalidation shall be conducted by the Education Program Specialist of Division of City Schools Manila and Quezon City.


Assigned EPS at Payatas center assessed and revalidated 33 learners, while assigned EPS at Parola center assessed and revalidated 32 learners. Blessed Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan

May 15, 2021



Saints are persons recognized as having an exceptional decree of holiness or closeness to God. Becoming one of them is really a long and tough journey. The community that works for the sainthood of a particular person must convince the church that this person had lived a holy life and miracles happened after intercession on his or her name. The process is composed of three stages after giving the title of Servant of God to candidate for sainthood.

The campaign for the sainthood of Fr. Francis started in 1942 when the congregation submitted all the necessary requirements to start the process of his sainthood and given the title of Servant of God. After 69 years of investigation, studies and tough deliberation, Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI in 2011 acknowledged the heroicity of Fr. Francis' virtues and officially announced that he lived a holy life and given the title of Venerable (the first stage for sainthood). On June 19, 2020, Pope Francis approved the beatification of Fr. Jordan and decreed the validity of a miracle gained through the intercession on his name.

May 15, 2021 a momentous event happened in Basilica of St. John Lateran in Rome. The Venerable Fr. Francis Mary of the Cross Jordan was beatified and was given a title of Blessed. Cardinal Vicar of Rome Angelo De Donatis initiated the mass for the Rite of Fr. Francis' beatification. On the same date in the Philippines, Society of the Divine Savior headed by Fr. Adam Janus, SDS together with the sisters and lay groups of Salvatorian held a thanksgiving mass in Divine Mercy Parish in Silang Cavite for the beatification of their founder.

This unforgettable event has moved the heart not only the members of Salvatorian Community but also those men and women who witnessed this significant moment. The hard

works of every member of Salvatorian family pushed call for the beatification of their founder. But, what makes Fr. Francis more holy, is the way of Salvatorian congregation unites as one, lives the mission, and acts as a disciple in every corner of the world.





Beatification Mass of Fr. Jordan at Divine Mercy Parish, Philippines
