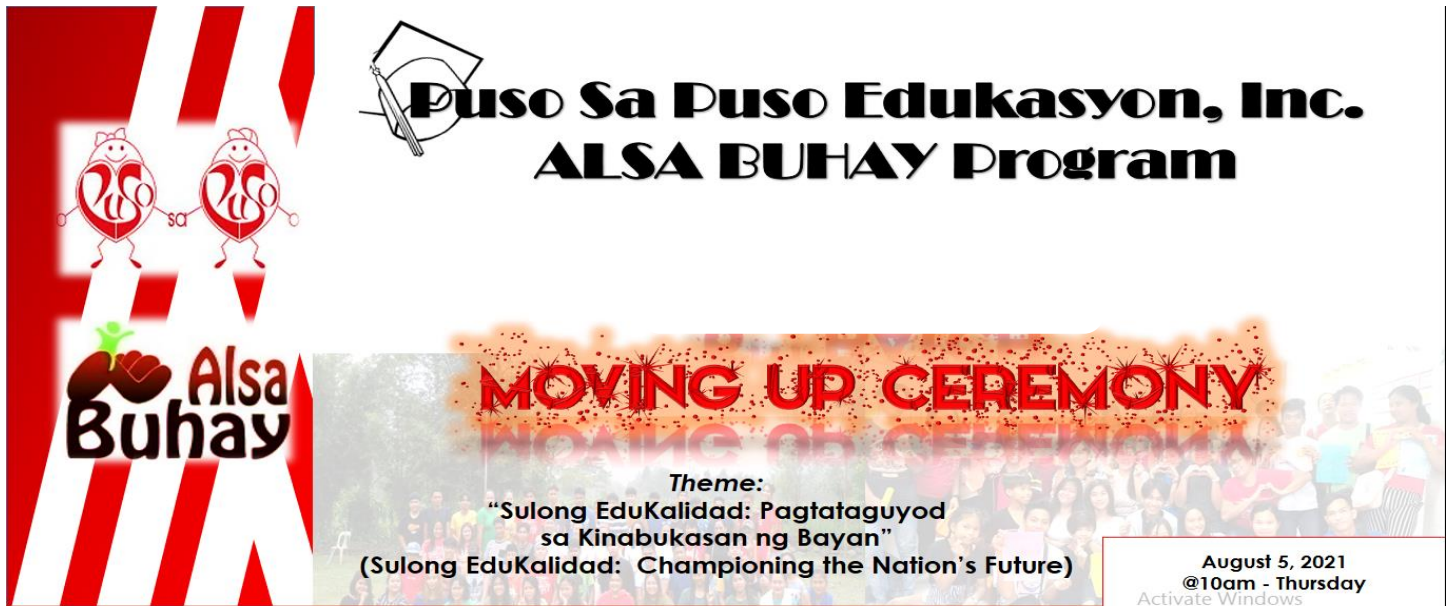




Moving Up Ceremony 2020

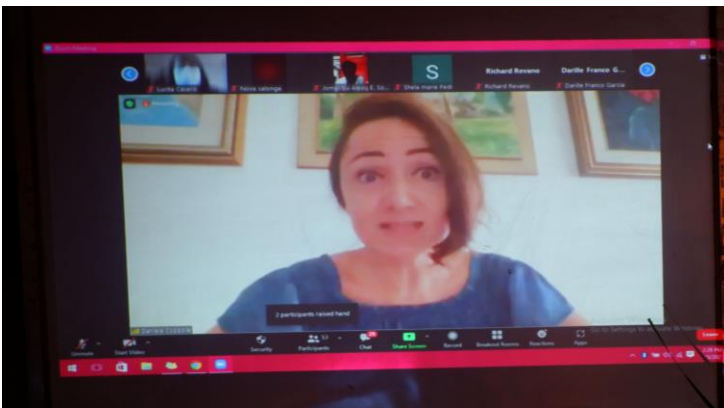
