April 27-28, 2022

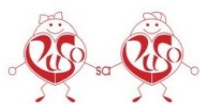

Payatas Center's Renovation 2022

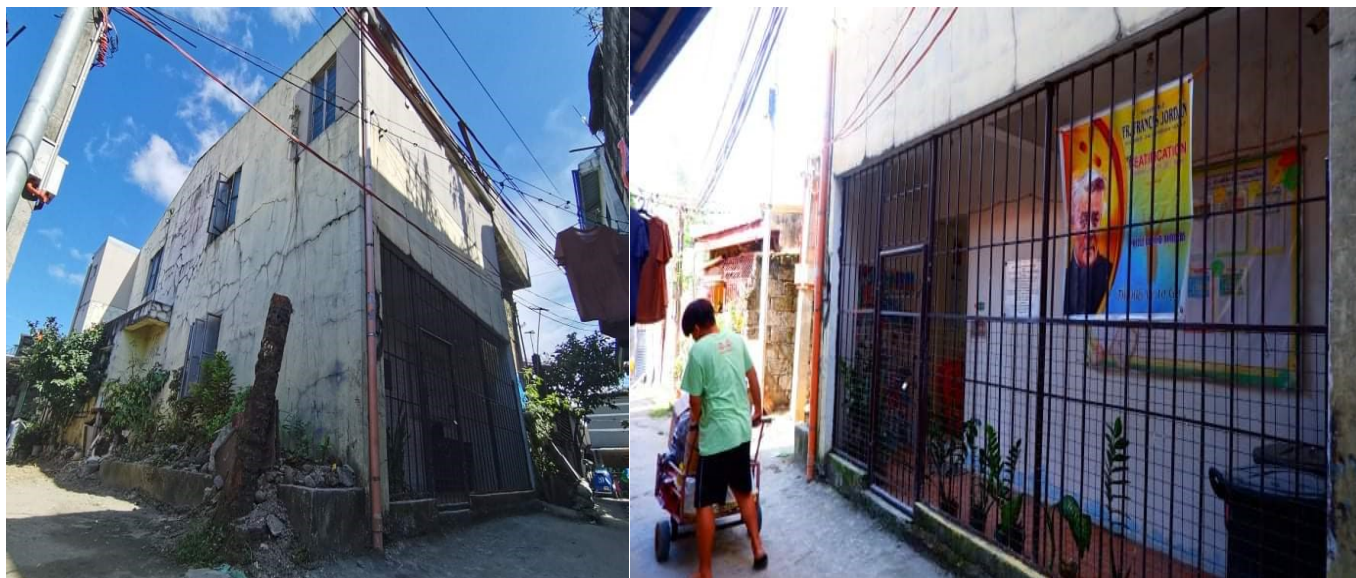
June 2022

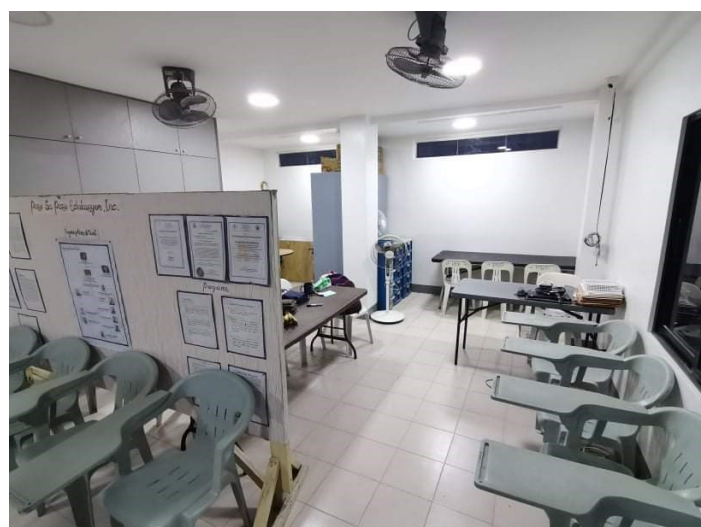
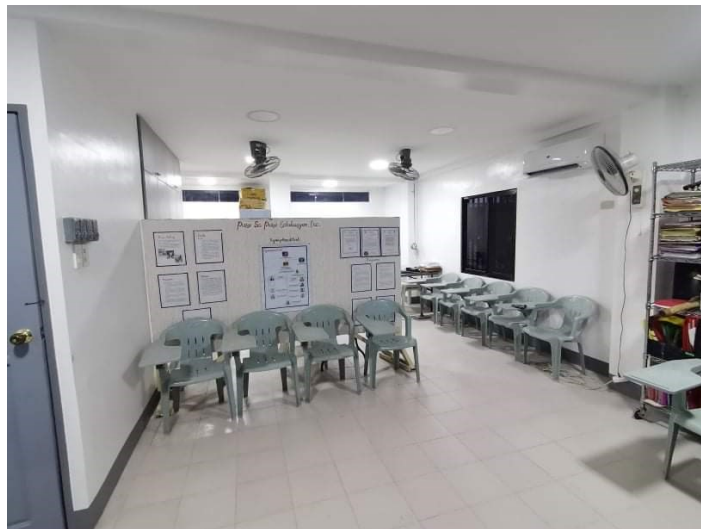
