



December 5, 2019





December 7, 2019





Payatas and Parola learners' Charity Event becomes an annual event in the lives of people within ALSA BUHAY center. For four years, it is a collaborative effort of learners, staff, and the institution itself in giving back to the needy especially the respective community we are catering with. This event resonates the true identity and mission of Pusong Sa Pusong Edukasyon, Inc. - the value of stewardship and generosity of serving the least, the lost, and the last.

The event culminates the almost 4 months of laborious effort of raising fund thru livelihood program. Producing and selling sweet treats, delicacies, rugs, dishwashing and alike. From a little capital, it grows like a mustard tree. The main actors and donors? Our dear learners who are also striving in their lives and also considered needy of basic necessities.

Payatas learners organized a Children's Charity event and of the five teams for this batch, they were able to raise a total of P17,900.00 budget for the said activity. Present also were the staff and administrator of Pusong Sa Pusong with Sr. Gloria Alonzo, CMT from National Shrine of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel who donated also gifts to our beneficiaries. 
