June 18, 2020




Puso Sa Puso staff together with the English teachers at SLI were invited to attend the training seminar about the New Normal Teaching Approach and adapting the new change in educational set-up of both participants. It was planned and organized by Fr. Artur Chrzanowski, SDS and with the help of the invited speaker Dr. Dindo Inso. The said training seminar was held at Salvatorian Learning Institute and via Zoom Meeting.

In the new educational arrangement in the Philippines, the Online and Modular learning approach is now introduced by the Department of Education as the new learning path for the learners. Online learning means the teachers and learners will be undertaking the learning activities and processes online, and together at the same time, through web conferencing platforms. However, Modular learning means that there will be structured activities that learners have to do at their own pace and time, not simultaneously with the rest of the class.

By embracing this new educational arrangement, Dr. Dindo Inso discussed, taught, and helped everyone on: How to make a module, the important things that should be included in a module. How to navigate online platforms in teaching; Zoom, Google meet, Messenger, the different usage and importance of every button to click on. The netiquette in online teaching, the do's and don'ts in front of the camera. And lastly, the new teaching approach via Online. For the final output of the participants, everyone was asked to do a demonstration teaching of everyone's subject matter masterpieces thru online.








The current COVID 19 pandemic is affecting every dimension of the Philippine education sector and with the consistent Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan, the Department of Education is currently taking measures to ensure that access to basic education services continue in the face of the global pandemic. This includes ensuring that out-of-school youth and adults who have completed ALS learning programs are able to seek certification of their learning through an A&E assessment and certification process.

June 2020, a circulated DepEd memorandum published that the Department of Education through the ALS Task Force announced the administration of Alternative Assessment and certification process comprising an A&E Readiness Test (AERT) supported by a presentation of Portfolio for both elementary and junior high school. ALS Completers are required to prepare a presentation portfolio for evaluation before they register for the AERT as additional evidence of their mastery of competencies in the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum. The presentation of portfolio is a collection of a learner's achievements, assembled specifically for assessment.

PSPEI staff planned, gathered materials, and disseminated the information to the dearest learners thru online via group chat. In lieu, their IMs sent take home activities to be started at home and to fill the outputs for their portfolio. In response, learners started to continue and prepare their presentation portfolio. Their IMs are responsible for certifying these formal records. The work samples may include a project undertaken by the learner, either individually or as a member of a group, and samples of activities undertaken by the learner that demonstrate learning accomplishments.




June 29, 2020, the Universidad de Manila conferred a virtual graduation ceremony with the theme "UDM BEATS COVID-19 #COVID KA LANG, UDM KAMI". This virtual graduation happened for the first time in history due to Coronavirus pandemic. The virtual ceremony, participated by 1,306 graduates and streamed in various social media platforms.



September 15-17, 2020




Comprehensive sexuality education is a curriculum-based process of teaching and learning about the cognitive, emotional, physical and social aspects of sexuality. It aims to equip children and young people with knowledge, skills, attitudes and values that will empower them to realize their health, well-being and dignity; develop respectful social and sexual relationships; considering how their choices affect their own well-being.

Learners of ALSA BUHAY Parola Center participated in a 3-day webinar training seminar organized by Philippine Family Organization of the Philippines (FPOP)Community Health Care Clinic. It was entitled Comprehensive Sexuality Education and Covid-19 Prevention and held last September 15- 17, 2020 thru online. It was a free seminar with load allowance, Covid-19 kit, and certificate. It was attended by twenty selected learners from Puso Sa Puso Edukasyon Inc.

Various slides presentation lessons were shown to the participants about Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), HIV/AIDS, and Teenage pregnancy. September 27, 2020





As we celebrate the World Teacher's Day, the Department of Education also set the opening of classes for the country on this day. It will be noted that due to current situation and pandemic, the classes were delayed for almost 4 months. The usual face to face learning modality is set aside and new and blended approach becoming the trend across all the levels of education.


Unlike the usual first day where learners and PSPEI staff of both centers are excited in this new chapter, a rare sighting is observed. There were limited interactions, each were cautious wearing personal protective masks and face shield, and the transactions were direct and at the minimum.

In order for safe opening of schools, health and safety protocols are observed. And because of ongoing city ordinance, only parents/guardians and learners above 21 years old are allowed to go outside. Contact tracing form is also used and asked visitors to sign before making interactions with the staff. Scheduling and social distancing is strictly observed.

For each learner, a 'learning kit' is given. It consists of disposable mask, notebook, pen, Modified Functional Literacy Test (MFLT) and Portfolio forms. A short instructions were given after they got their respective learning kits.

For this month, enrollment is still open. Those who already enlisted, fulfilment of various forms and documentation are required for submission. Life skill modules, as ordered by DepEd-ALS will follow thru blended learning.

(7th Batch)




The production of ALSA BUHAY Essentials was done in both centers – Payatas and Parola.

“Pandemic has given us negative thoughts of uncertainties threats, doubts”.




